Info about Germany:

Germany, with a population of approximately 84.08 million, is the most economically strong country in the European Union. Germany was the birthplace of the Reformation. It was once a base for world missions but is now in spiritual darkness. Its recent history of war and the repression of communism experienced in the former East Germany has left a spiritual malaise of indifference to the gospel. Christianity is being marginalized and the Church is widely perceived as irrelevant. Operation World Reports that there is a growing indifference towards the Christian message. There is also a growing number of immigrants coming to major cities in Germany which also provides a unique opportunity for ministry to a people who have not heard the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

What will be happening in Germany:

Willingdon Church will be sending a team to Bielefeld Germany from July 5-14 to assist with a Summer Camp run by the Bielefeld Church.
