When you think about following Jesus, how much does the word “danger” enter into the picture? Or do you believe he is someone who leads us into dangerous places, places that risk all of our comfort, even our lives?

- Figure out what crowd(s) you need to step out of.
- Be aware of Jesus’ presence as you step into the danger
- Only by following Jesus into the danger will we experience Kingdom Power

Questions for Reflection:

- Do you consider following Jesus to be dangerous? And if so, how?
- What “crowds” do you see yourself in? How is Jesus calling you to step out?
- Are there dangerous places that you avoided Jesus leading you to? Would you approach it differently next time?
