Today's Big Idea is... **God Is With Us**

Today we learned that Abraham had a great grandson named Joseph. Joseph had many brothers, but he was his father, Jacob's favourite. This made his brothers so angry that they threw him into a big hole in the ground. Even though Joseph was scared, **God was with Joseph**. When the brothers saw some people passing by their way to Egypt, they sold Joseph to them. When Joseph got to Egypt, he helped the pharaoh understand his dreams that didn't make sense. Joseph helped take care of the people through a time when there was not enough food for everyone! When Joseph's bothers ran out of food, they traveled to Egypt to get some and they saw Joseph again! Joseph knew **God was with him** the entire time and told his family that God used him to take care of others.
