- 4. What do you learn about God's mercy and faithfulness?

Family Activity:

Make an origami boat or a boat from other craft supplies. Test the boat's ability to float in a swimming pool, a pond, or your bathtub. Review the story of Noah. Help your kids understand why God punishes sin and how He has lovingly made a way—like the ark for Noah—through Jesus for us to be saved.
