God had a plan for Joseph's life. He allowed Joseph to suffer in order to rescue a whole nation. God planned for Jesus to suffer so that many people from all nations would be saved. Our key verse is Psalm 135:5-6: I know that the Lord is great. I know that our Lord is greater than all gods. The Lord does whatever he pleases in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all the depths.

Four Key Questions:

Use these questions as you go through this week's Bible passages.

- 1. Did you understand this passage? What was it about?
- 2. What do we learn about God from this passage? What do we learn about people?
- 3. Are there any commands to obey or promises to remember in this passage? Why do they matter?
- 4. How do we see God's good plan at work in this passage?

Family Activity:

Bake something, (like bread, brownies, or cinnamon rolls) together as a family. Give each family member a job like measuring, mixing, kneading, or shaping the dough. Some jobs might be more difficult or less enjoyable than others, but each step is still important to get to the end result. Talk about all the things Joseph went through and how God used each of those things in His plan... and that God's plan was good! God knew the end result. Next, discuss how God might use your family to help others know Jesus and believe in Him. Enjoy the bread or treat you have made as the happy ending of your hard work.
