BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS

- Are there any stories/conversations from the holiday season that stand out to you that you'd like to share?
- 2. To what degree do you think the North American Church experiences suffering because of their faith?
 - a. Is persecution increasing or decreasing? Why?
 - b. Have you experienced any suffering because of your beliefs?
 - c. What is the primary reason Christians experience persecution?
- 3. Think back to the last time someone asked you about your faith. If you can't think of a time, why do you think that is? If you can think of a time, how did you respond to that person? Did you feel prepared for the conversation?
- There are bible verses that speak about sharing the gospel boldly. Peter calls for believers to speak with gentleness and respect.
 - a. What do you think the balance should be between boldness and gentleness when talking about the gospel?
 - b. How do you know when to emphasize one or the other?
- One of the best ways to "give a reason for the hope that is in you" is to share your story.
 - a. If you haven't already, take time this week to write out your story (testimony) in a length that you could share in 5 minutes or less.
 - Pray that God brings to mind someone to share your story with and opportunities to share this coming week.

Ist Century Christians lived in an unfriendly, sometimes even hostile, environment where their faith had psychological, social and economic consequences. They had to wrestle with a number of temptations: (1) the temptation to shame those that maligned them; (2) to carefully privatize their faith to avoid exclusion; (3) to become so politically correct that their witness would be muted; and (4) to lose all enthusiasm for sharing their faith. We may tell ourselves, "No one wants to hear about Jesus anyways." How do we share our faith, as disciples of Jesus, when we live in a challenging environment where our biblical convictions seem to be unwelcome?

- Prepare your <u>heart</u>
 - a. Do not fear them (v14b)
 - b. Fear the One they don't (v15a)
- 2. Be prepared to give an <u>answer</u> (v15)
 - a. Share the reason for the hope in you
 - b. Share with gentleness and respect
 - c. Keep a good conscience
- 3. Remember, you will be blessed
