March 17 & 18, 2018

All people experience social pressure to some degree. It can be used to maintain order or to encourage horrific acts. Sometimes people will do things they would normally not do because of the authority of a person, a group, or an ideology in their lives. What ultimately determines our actions? What enables us to walk away from unhealthy social compliance?

Main Point: When we face social pressure, in order to choose Jesus instead of the kingdom of this world, we must be secure in our Godgiven identity, know our God-given purpose and be committed to God's truth.

For us to avoid social compliance...

- 1. Our core identity must be rooted in God the Father, not the social group
- 2. Our core purpose must be to know and witness to the truth, not to secure social acceptance
- 3. Our core truth must be defined by Jesus, not by our social environment
