In Jesus' last discourse in the Gospel of Matthew (chapters 24-25), He looks down a corridor of time toward His Second Coming. Jesus teaches His disciples how they are to live each day in preparation for His return. What does "living ready" for His Second Coming look like? The Parable of the Talents instructs us.

- 1. Live ready for Jesus' return
- 2. With gratitude, acknowledge God's huge investment in you
- 3. Take Kingdom <u>risks</u> with what God has entrusted to you. Do not play it <u>safe</u>
- 4. Invest all that God has entrusted <u>without fear</u>. God wants to give you <u>more</u>
- 5. God has invested in you for His <u>eternal purposes</u>. Know <u>your purpose</u> and live it!
