- 4. In the book of Acts, the Holy Spirit was poured out on believers from all nations. This past weekend, we celebrated the different nations represented in Willingdon Church. What are some of the blessings and challenges of being a church that is home to so many language groups and cultures?
- 5. How do you feel called to respond to this week's text and sermon? What steps of obedience do you feel the Spirit is calling you to take this week?

May 19 & 20, 2018

Imagine if you were asked to play the Mongolian horse fiddle right now. What would you feel? You would probably feel a mix of emotions: anxiety, fear, doubt, confusion. You may question the wisdom of the person making the request. Why are you being asked to do what you are not prepared to do?

We all experience feelings like doubt, fear, anxiety, worry. No ethnic or language group is exempt from these emotions. They are integral to being human. In today's passage, John 14:15-27, the disciples are experiencing these emotions and there is reason for it. What will Jesus say to them?

The Helping Presence is the best help the disciples could ever have, because...

- 1. He will be with them all the time, now and forever
- 2. He will be the "same kind" as the first Helper, Jesus
- 3. He will not only be "with" them, but "in" them!
- 4. He will not only be imagined; He will be experienced
- 5. He will teach the disciples all things
- 6. He will be the Peace of God within them, always
