In Genesis 4, the first son of Adam and Eve, Cain, murders his brother, Abel. In verse 16 we read; “Then Cain went away from the presence of the LORD and settled in the land of Nod, east of Eden.” Our headlines this week follow the same script: “Mali declares three days of national mourning for massacre victims” (Aljazeera); “Hong Kong shuts government offices as protests over China extradition bill turn violent” (The Globe and Mail); “Inside the elementary school where addiction sets the curriculum” (The New York Times). Why do we continue to live east of Eden?

1. Know that the power of **Satan** is in the **lie**
2. Know that the essence of temptation is to believe that it is **better for you** to go your **own way**
3. Know that the consequences of sin are always **alienation** from God, **separation** from other people and **self-destruction**
4. When we follow Satan’s counsel, we become people **of the lie**
5. Know that the Tempter, temptation, and sin’s consequences are **overcome** only through **Jesus**
