LIFE GROUPS

1. Take some time to catch up. How did this week go? What steps of obedience did you take and what has God been teaching you?
2. Take time to read John 3:1-21. What stands out to you from the text and/or sermon that Pastor Willy preached? Is there something that you did not know/notice before?
3. In this text, Nicodemus is seeking a human solution to a spiritual problem. Have you ever tried to use a human solution for a spiritual problem? How did that work out for you?
4. Nicodemus was a ruler and teacher of Israel. He would have been morally upright, well-respected, and knowledgeable about the Bible. If Nicodemus needed a new birth, what does that tell us about the human condition?
5. John 3:16 is probably the most famous verse in the Bible. We have all heard it before, but how does hearing it in its original context help us to appreciate it even more?
6. How do you feel led to respond to this week's message and text? Are there steps of obedience you feel the Spirit asking you to take? How can we pray for you as a group?

September 29 & 30, 2018

When we come to church, we often have questions. We wonder if people will accept us or judge us. We wonder if we're going to meet real people or perhaps just some religious fanatics. We also wonder if we will discover something significant for our lives. We wonder if there is more to Jesus than what we see in the media. Can we actually have a relationship with Jesus like people talk about? Will Jesus make a difference in our lives? In the language of Willingdon we would say we're explorers, exploring who Jesus is, who His people are, and what the implications are for our lives.

Today's text is about an explorer. Now, he happens to be a religious explorer. What is a religious explorer? This is a person who knows about God, who knows about religion, but he really doesn't know who Jesus is. This is a person who doesn't know what it means to actually follow Jesus or believe in Jesus or have a relationship with Jesus. If you're exploring Christianity then you have a lot in common with the main character in today's text.
