LIFE GROUPS

1. Take some time to catch up. How did this week go? What steps of obedience did you take and what has God been teaching you?
2. Take time to read John 6:16-21. What stands out to you from the text and/or sermon that Pastor Ray preached? Was there something you hadn't noticed before?
3. By walking on the water, calming the storm, and immediately bringing the disciples to their destination, Jesus does three miracles that reveal who he is. What do these miracles reveal about Jesus? Read Job 9:8 and Psalm 107:28-30 to help you answer this.
4. The disciples went through a literal storm on the Sea of Galilee; however, we also face 'storms' in our own lives. Where are the winds of adversity blowing in your life today? Where are the waves rocking your world?
5. In his sermon, Pastor Ray said, "It's more about meeting Jesus in the storm than getting out of the storm." Have there been times in your life when you have gone through a difficult time that forced you to rely on God more fully? Share about what that was like.
6. How do you feel led to respond to this week's message and text? Are there steps of obedience you feel the Spirit asking you to take? How can we pray for you as a group?

2. Jesus watches over and intercedes for his disciples.
3. Jesus comes and manifests himself to his disciples on his terms.
4. Jesus invites his disciples to exercise faith in the middle of the storm.
5. Jesus intervenes and calms the storm for his disciples.
6. Jesus carries his disciples to their destination.
