The book of Genesis tells the grand story of humanity. It begins with the good news: people are made in the image of God. We are created to have relationship with God. He looked at His creation, at Adam and Eve, and called His creation, "very good." Creation was filled with hope! Then comes the bad news: people didn't want relationship with God on His terms. Adam and Eve thought they were better off without God. Relationship with God was broken and ever since that day all of humanity suffers with the consequences of that decision. 1. Hope is **possible** if we are willing to **face reality**

 - a. God **banished** Adam and Eve to **save** them from **themselves**
 - b. God **initiated** hope in His **discipline** of Adam and Eve
3. Hope is **possible** when we are willing to **assess** our spiritual **condition**
4. Hope is **found** when we **recognize** our **need** for God's **grace**
5. Hope is found when we **respond** to God's **grace** by **placing** our **faith** in Jesus
