Ethics in Room 21C. What is meant by Room 21C? We live in “Room 21C”, the room of the 21st century. What about ethics? The cover of a recent issue of Macleans magazine reads: **“Join the Compassion Revolution (or we’re all doomed): There’s an urgent call for more compassion as the last gasp remedy for systems at the brink – politics, health care, the planet itself – but do we even have it in us?”** The tone of the article reflects “care ethics” where empathy and compassion are highly valued.
