It is hard for us to embrace any kind of restriction outside of our own desires. Why would it be called the "great sin" in Scripture?

 - c. The **bearing** wall under which children learn **faithful love**
 - d. A union that models Jesus' eternal union with us

- 4. Confess your sins to the One who can restore you
- 5. <u>Cultivate</u> an intimate relationship with <u>God</u>, your <u>spouse</u>, and your <u>church family</u>
