Sermon

August 24 & 25, 2019

Impatience reveals something about our human nature that we need to be acutely aware of. We tend to want to find our comfort, security, and worth in things that are tangible; things that we can control to deal with our impatience. When we act in our impatience, we can easily put our personal agenda above God's plan for us. The story of Exodus 32 is a stark reminder of the high price we pay when we act in our impatience.

- 1. When we become impatient with God, our <u>true idols</u> will be <u>revealed</u>
- 2. When we pursue our <u>personal</u> idols, we will need <u>help</u> to restore our relationship with God
- 3. When we <u>minimize</u> our idolatry, we are <u>pushing away</u> God's <u>leading</u>, God's <u>peace</u>, and God's <u>work</u> in our lives
- 4. The <u>best</u> and <u>only</u> healthy response to idolatry is to ask for God's <u>forgiveness</u> and <u>receive</u> His cleansing in our lives
 - a. Admit it
 - b. Own it
 - c. Confess it
