In our day, the word *empower* is a popular word. We use it to refer to helping people become stronger or more confident in some aspect of their lives. Exercise programs, retirement plans, financial institutions, even libraries (e.g., Burnaby Public Library) use empowerment language to describe what they're about. When we think about empowerment, we often think about ensuring our rights and becoming more independent. What does empowerment look like in the life of a Christ-follower? Is it any different from what happens in society around us today?

- 1. When God empowers us...
 - a. We are affirmed by His people
 - b. We are empowered by the <u>transformative</u>, <u>enabling</u> presence of the <u>Spirit</u>
 - c. We are authorized by church leadership
- 2. When empowered by the Spirit, Jesus will lead us to...
 - a. Submit to church leadership
 - b. Proclaim His <u>message</u> by <u>word</u> and <u>deed</u>
 - c. Be people of **forgiveness**
 - d. Serve wherever He takes us
