

January 4 & 5, 2020

Last weekend, we studied the first half of the Lord's Prayer. This week, we will look at the second half of the Lord's Prayer.

- Asking for daily bread brings us back <u>into God's presence</u>, and teaches us to <u>depend on God</u>
 - a. The frequency of this prayer is constant: Daily
 - b. The subject of the request is basic: Bread
- 2. Jesus wants His people to be a family of forgiveness
- Praying <u>against temptation</u> and for <u>deliverance from evil</u> indicates <u>a battle</u>
 - a. We need prayer for protection in warfare
 - b. We need prayer for warfare against the enemy
- 4. To close the Lord's Prayer, we declare the Kingdom, Power, and Glory of Jesus to come through the Holy Spirit
