All spiritual gifts are an expression of who Jesus is. And, the image of Jesus is reflected most completely when all members of the church family are walking in their spiritual gifting. Jesus specifically gifted the church with five leadership streams. They represent five ways of directing people to align their hearts with God's purposes, of casting God's vision for His people, and of motivating God's people toward carrying on Jesus' ministry.

1. **Apostles** lead people to Jesus by going to new **regions** and new **people groups**, proclaiming and demonstrating the **reign of God**
2. **Prophets** lead people to Jesus by **speaking forth** God's word to His people
3. **Evangelists** lead people to Jesus by **sharing** the Good News of Jesus **with joy**
4. **Teachers** lead people to Jesus by **explaining** God's truth, as revealed in **Scripture**, in such a way that people know how to **live it** in their context
5. **Shepherds** lead people to Jesus by **example**, **loving** them and **caring** for them
