Over the last few months, we have been studying the spiritual gifts so that we might be more aware of how God has equipped us by His Spirit and, as a result, serve Jesus more faithfully and joyfully. Every follower of Jesus has received a spiritual gift or gifts.

Today, we conclude this series with the gift of prophecy. Some of you may be filled with excitement, others may be nervous, and yet others may be confused. Why would we desire the gift of prophecy at Willingdon?

A. The gift of prophecy is:

- 1. God encouraging, consoling, and building up the church family
- 2. God's Word spoken to God's people under the inspiration of the Spirit
- 3. God's message is communicated in at least three forms:
 - a. The prophetic application of the written Word of God
 - b.The prediction of the future
 - c. A personal message revealing God's heart for a specific person or group

B. The true prophetic gift:

- Never speaks contrary to the <u>Bible</u>
- 2. Emphasizes the lordship of Jesus
- 3. Leads followers of Jesus and visitors to worship God
- 4. Is for the **common** good
- 5. Speaks in continuity with God's revealed direction
- 6. Does not alter the **personality** or **language** of the prophet
- 7. Never leads us away from the way of love
- 8.1s clear and leads to obedience
- C. Orientation for those who earnestly desire the gift of prophecy:
 - 1. Saturate yourself in the written Word of God
 - 2. Worship, pray, and fast
 - 3. Walk in humility before your leaders and the church family
 - 4. Learn from those with prophetic gifting
