# FAITH @ HOME

God went ahead of Joshua and the Israelites into the promised land. He showed His power to them so they would trust in Him. When Jesus came to earth, He showed His power so people would trust in Him and be saved from sin. Our key verse is Psalm 119:105: **Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.**

## Four Key Questions:

Use these questions as you go through this week's Bible passages.

1. Did you understand this passage? What was it about?
2. What do we learn about God from this passage? What do we learn about people?
3. Are there any commands to obey or promises to remember in this passage? Why do they matter?
4. Have you (or your parents) seen God's power at work? What can you do to help you remember that God's power is with you?

## Family Activity:

Visit or call an elderly church member or older Christian your family knows. As you share a meal, talk, or visit together, ask the person to share stories of God's faithfulness to him or her. Encourage kids to ask questions and listen to learn more about who God is and how He displays His power.
