но Grades 2-5 FAITH @ HOME

Jesus died on the cross for our sins, but He didn't stay dead. God was pleased with Jesus' sacrifice and miraculously raised Jesus from the dead to prove He is the Son of God and salvation is found in Him. Our key verse is Psalm 77:14: **You are the God who performs miracles; you display your power among the peoples.**

Four Key Questions:

Use these questions as you go through this week's Bible passages.

- 1. Did you understand this passage? What was it about?
- 2. What do we learn about God from this passage? What do we learn about people?
- 3. Are there any commands to obey or promises to remember in this passage? Why do they matter?
- 4. Who do the people in this passage think Jesus is? Who do you say Jesus is? How will you respond?

Family Activity:

Use a poster board to write down as many miracles from the Bible as your family can remember. After you've made the list, look up the Scripture references (where it's found in the Bible) for each miracle and write it on the poster. Keep the poster as a reminder of God's miracles. Take a moment to thank Jesus for miraculously rising from the grave to give eternal life to all who believe in Him.
