As I walk around the stage, and look into the boxes, I find all kinds of hidden treasures. Jesus has something for us today. Jesus invites us to come to Him. Matthew 11:28 Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Come. One of His favorite words. He doesn't say come to religion, to church, or to spirituality. He invites us to come to Him, to trust Him personally, to walk with Him.

- · Acknowledge that you overburden yourself.
- · Acknowledge what your yoke is.
- Choose to receive the new yoke Jesus offers.
- · Ask Jesus to reveal His Father to you.
- Come to Jesus as a child.

- What is the yoke that you are wearing today? Are you overburdening yourself?
- Do you want to exchange your yoke for the yoke Jesus offers?
- What do you need to do today to put on Jesus' yoke?
