
## Willingdon Kids Weekend Volunteer Opportunities

TIMOLOGICO SPECIAL NEEDS	Imagine is a ministry for those with special needs. The role of an Imagine volunteer varies based on each child's unique needs. Volunteers build relationships with children and youth while encouraging them to engage with their peers and God's Word. During weekend services, volunteers meet their buddies in the Imagine room. Imagine volunteers will either support their buddy through the Imagine lesson or in their buddy's age- appropriate classroom. After the service, volunteers and their buddies return to the Imagine room where they spend time playing while they wait for their parents. ## Willingdon Kids Weekday and Seasonal Volunteer Opportunities

GIRL'S CLUB	Ignite is our girls club, for girls in grades 2-5. Girls come in for a large group worship and prayer time before splitting into age-specific small groups to work through different activities. Volunteers plan for and lead a small group, teaching Bible lessons and leading activities that help children to earn badges. PLAY SPACE	Playspace is a drop-in program for preschool aged children and their caregivers. Volunteers help set up, organize, and clean up activities, and play with children and their parents. willingdon Choir	Kids Choir has two sessions per year: one that starts in the fall for a Christmas performance, and one that starts in the New Year for a Spring performance. Volunteers help children learn the songs and actions, and may also help soloists and speakers learn their parts. Volunteers help keep everyone organized on performance days, and ensure children are fully supervised at all times.
