FAITH @ HOME

God chose Saul to be the Israelites' king. God sent His Son, Jesus, to be our King forever. Jesus brings together everyone who trusts in Him and gives us victory over sin and death. Our key verse is from Isaiah 6:5 **Woe to me! I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty.**

Four Key Questions:

Use these questions as you go through this week's Bible passages.

1. Did you understand this passage? What was it about?
2. What do we learn about God from this passage? What do we learn about people?
3. Are there any commands to obey or promises to remember in this passage? Why do they matter?
4. What can we learn from Ruth and/or Boaz's actions in this passage?

Family Activity:

Find a time to think and chat about Canada's history and how sin has caused Indigenous peoples to be hurt. God brought Israel together to defeat their enemy as Jesus defeats our sin and brings all people together for His Kingdom. Pick a tribe in the lower mainland to research and pray for. Pray for reconciliation and for the issues that Indigenous peoples are currently going through.
