- 3. What questions are still lingering?

## Questions

- 1. Why do we tell creation stories? What larger cultural purpose do they serve?
- 2. What does it mean that God is the Creator?
- 3. What is young earth creationism? What is old earth creationism?
- 4. What is the goal of creation? How does the way Genesis 1 is written point to this goal?
- 5. What are the differences in how God created the earth and how he created man and woman? What are these differences important? What is it that makes humanity distinct from the rest of creation?

- 6. What does it mean for us as people to bear the image of God? What responsibilities come with being made in God's image?
- 7. What does Genesis 1 teach us about God?
- 8. Read Colossians 1:15-20. What is the connection between Jesus' role in creation and the resurrection (re-creation)?
- 9. The image of God in us is tainted by our sin. How is that image restored and who restores it?
