FAITH @ HOME

God is present with us. He sent prophets to His people, even in captivity, and promised to send Immanuel, which means "God with us." Jesus fulfilled this promise when He came to earth and was born of a virgin. Jesus is our Immanuel, God with us. Memory Verse: Zephaniah 3:17 **The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.**

1. Did you understand this passage? What was it about?
2. What do we learn about God from this passage? What do we learn about people?
3. Are there any commands to obey or promises to remember in this passage? Why do they matter?
4. What does this passage teach you about God's Kingdom?

Some prayer items could be neighbours, friends, schools, churches, refugees. Then take some time to pray for the things that you listed.
