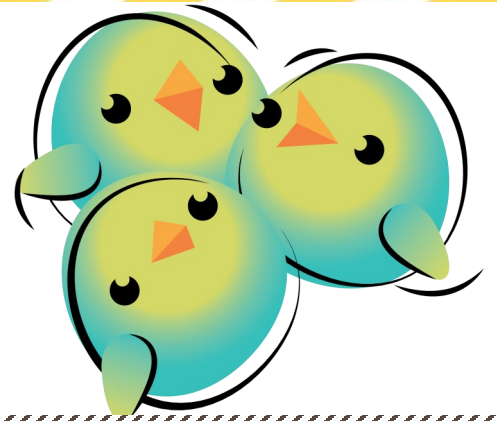

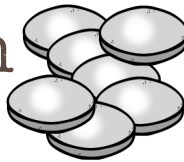

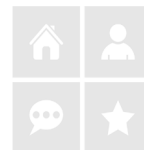
Family Fun At Home:
