Family Fun At Home:

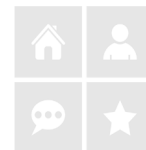
Hey Preschoolers, it's TIME to exercise! Take a long walk around your neighborhood, do 10 jumping jacks, play in the playground for 30 minutes.
