## Four Key Questions:

Use these questions as you go through this week's Bible passages.

1. Did you understand this passage? What was it about?

3. Are there any commands to obey or promises to remember in this passage? Why do they matter?
4. What does this passage teach you about God's Kingdom?



We want to help you learn and grow together as a family. Build a family routine that includes time spent reading the Bible and praying together. This could be in the morning, over dinner, at bedtime, or whenever else works for your family!

## Family Activity:

Play charades with your family. Write down animals, sports, activities, occupations, and chores on slips of paper and place them in a bowl. One person will draw a strip of paper and act out what is written while the rest of your family guesses. See how many you can guess correctly!

The religious leaders in our Bible story acted like they were righteous when they had sinful hearts. By studying God's Word, we can learn how to love and obey God in our thoughts, words, and actions. Take some time to pray, asking God to help us live like Jesus, to have clean hearts that love Him and love others, and to help us show love to others to bring them closer to Him!
