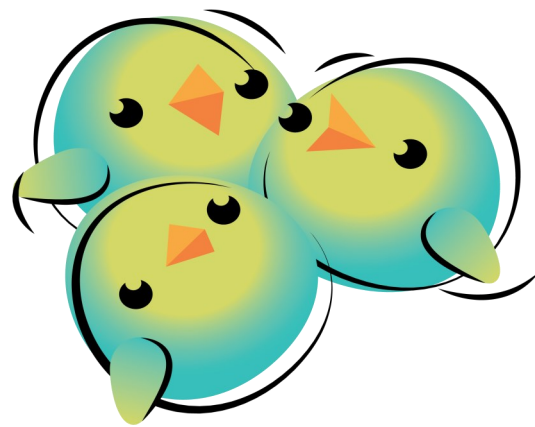

Today We Learned:

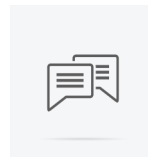

Family Fun At Home:

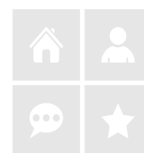
Make fingerprint hearts!
