
¹ LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

Written in 1958—66 years ago!




There is no nuance in the decision to kill another member of the human family.





Widow's mite



Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. 
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


Emmaus triptych


