**Application**

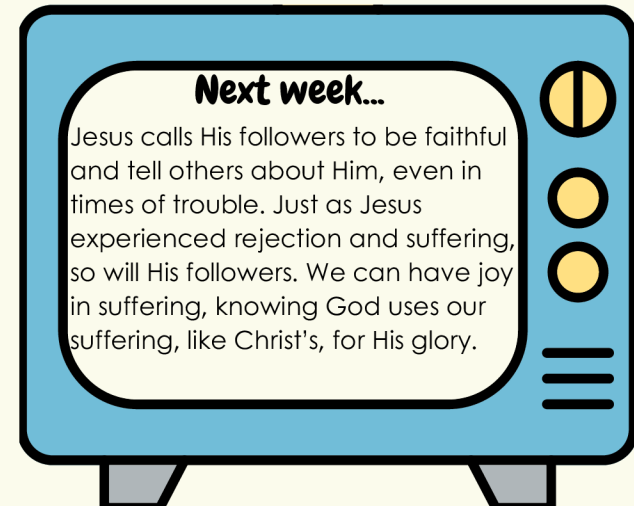
How does this scripture apply to your life? What is God trying to teach you through this passage? Is there something you need to change or do? Write down your thoughts.
