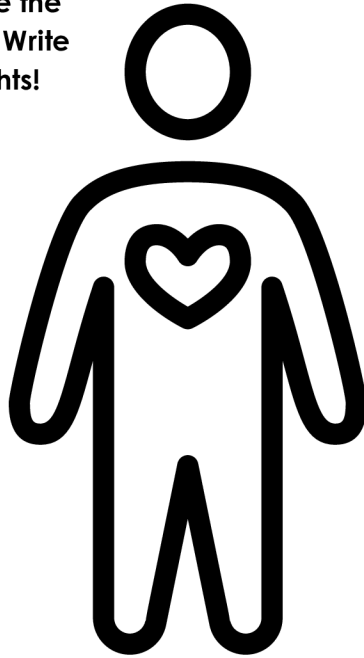

John 14: 15-31



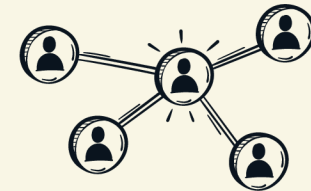

Family Activity:

How did you hear about being a Christian? Maybe it was from a family member, or from someone at school, or from a neighbour. Ask your parents how they heard about Jesus and being a Christian.

Application

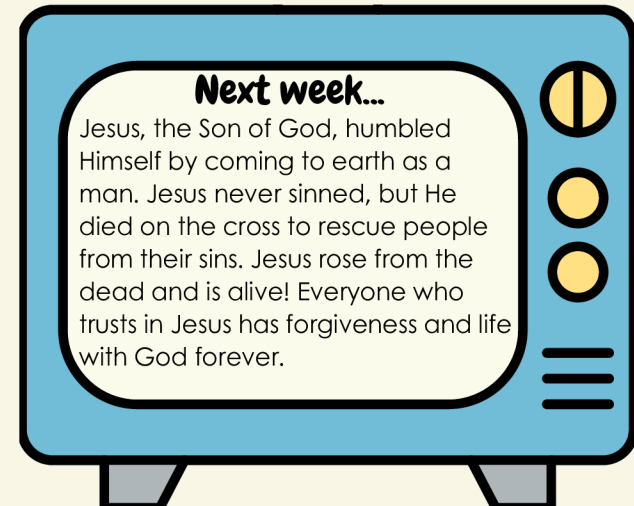
How does this scripture apply to your life? What is God trying to teach you through this passage? Is there something you need to change or do? Write down your thoughts.
