Drop off Nov 18-24

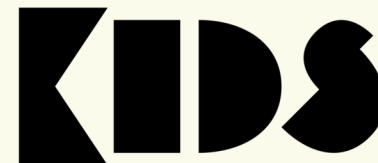

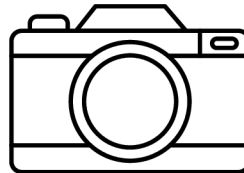
Day One
