Stephen was a man who loved Jesus. One day, some Jews told lies about Stephen because they did not like Stephen, and they wanted him to get in trouble. The high priest asked Stephen if the Jews were telling the truth. Stephen taught the religious leaders that Jesus is the Messiah, and the religious leaders were wrong to reject Him and kill Him on the cross. The religious leaders did not like what Stephen was saying. When Stephen looked up and said, "I see Jesus standing at God's right side. The people got upset and yelled, covered their ears, and rushed toward Stephen. They made Stephen leave the city, and then they threw rocks at him.
