Paul wrote a letter and said that the church works together like one body. "Think about the human body," Paul wrote. "It is one body, but it is made up of many parts. All the parts are important and it work together as one body." There are many different people who belong to Jesus. Paul wrote, "A foot shouldn't say, 'I am not a hand, so I am not part of the body.' A foot is just as much a part of the body as a hand. God has made each part of the body just as He wanted. An eye can't say to the hand, 'I do not need you!' and the head can't say to the feet, 'I do not need you!'" Paul said that the church like the human body should be one. "Not everyone is the same, but every part of the body of Christ is important."

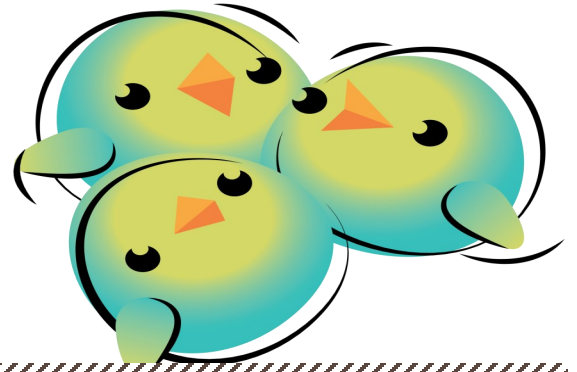

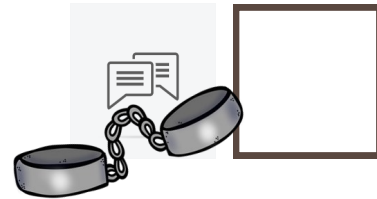

King Herod put Peter in prison. Believers in the church prayed and asked God to help him. Peter was sleeping in prison when suddenly an angel woke him up. The chains fell off of Peter's wrists and he followed the angel out of the prison. He walked past the guards and the gate opened for them. Then the angel left. After God rescued Peter, he hurried to a house where other believers were praying. When Peter knocked at the door, a servant named Rhoda answered. She heard Peter's voice and she was so happy she ran back inside without letting Peter in. "Peter is here!" she said. "He is at the door!" No one believed her. But Peter kept knocking, so they opened the door and welcomed him in. Peter told them how the Lord had rescued him from prison.

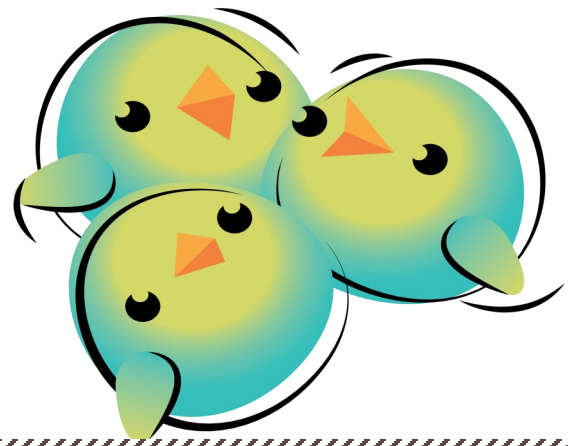

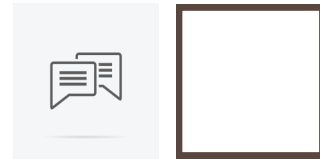

During this time, the believers that travelled to Antioch shared the message of Jesus with others. When the people heard the good news, more people believed in Jesus. Stephen said, "Jesus, forgive them!" and then he died.

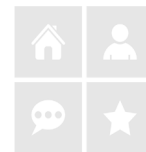

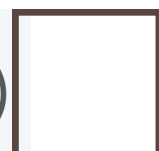
