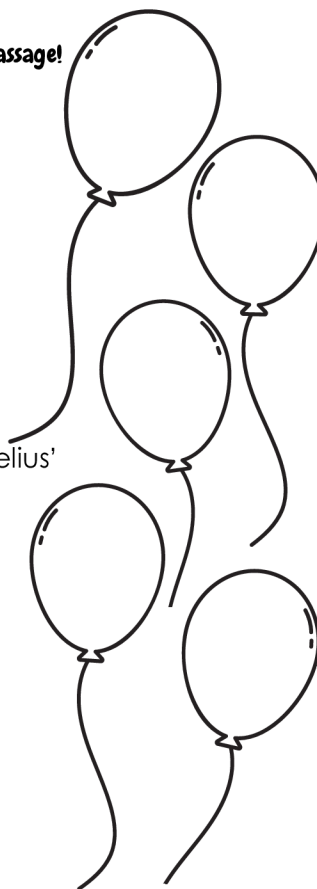

What did you notice while reading? Write it down. Circle words you don't understand. Underline words that repeat. Write down any questions you have.

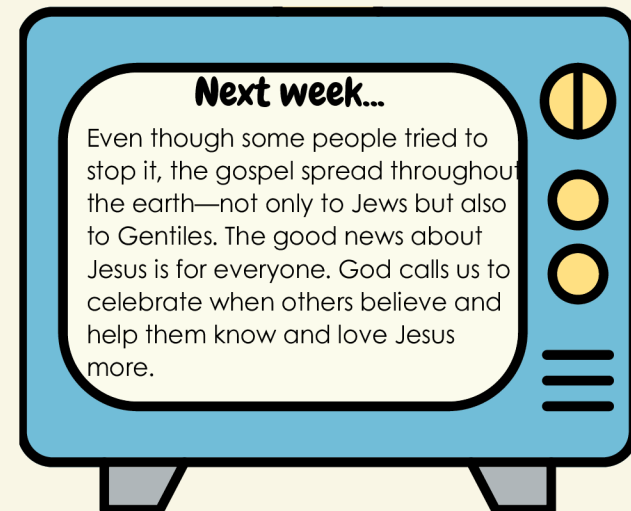
**P**rayer
