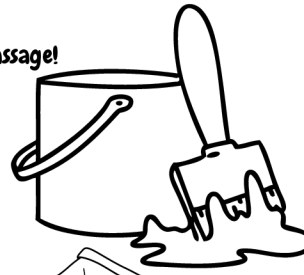

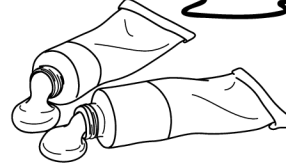
Day One

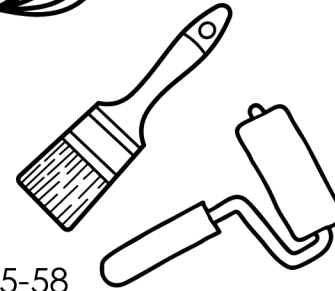
