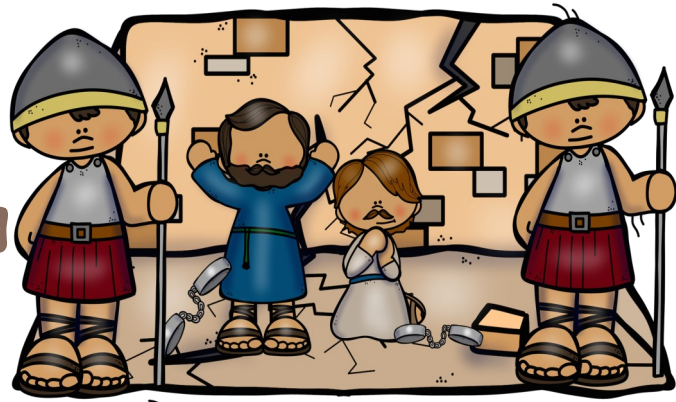

Paul wrote letters to the church in Corinth reminding Jesus' followers in the church that because of Jesus, God forgives our sin and invites us into His family forever. Paul shared the good news that Jesus came into the world to rescue sinners. Paul wrote, "We want to obey God and tell people about Jesus because Jesus loves us. We love Him too!" Jesus changes everything. Paul wrote, "When we follow Jesus, we are changed. If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, and the new has come!" Something amazing happened when Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead. Paul wrote, "God made us right through Jesus." God gives us the mission of telling others about Jesus.
