In today's passage, Matthew 19:1-15, Jesus makes his final withdrawal from Galilee and embarks on his final journey toward Jerusalem. In light of these sayings, the Pharisees' question for Jesus in verse 1 is stunning. They want to know if they can divorce for any and every reason. The direction of their question is diametrically opposed to the heart of Jesus for married couples and their children.
