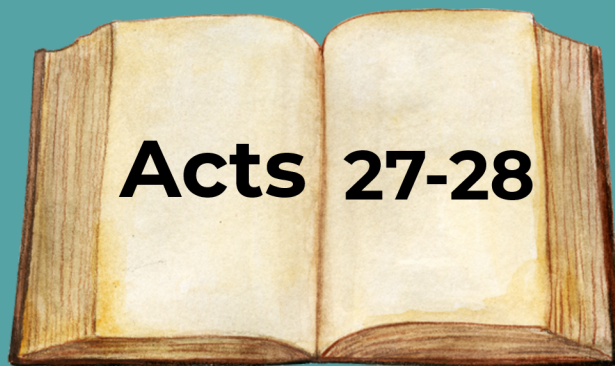

Scripture

Pick a verse or passage that stuck out to you the most and write it down.

Observation

What did you notice while reading? Write it down.

Application

How does this scripture apply to your life? What is God trying to teach you through this passage? Is there something you need to change or do? Write down your thoughts.

Prayer

Talk to God about what He's teaching you. Ask Him how to meditate on and apply this scripture to your life.

We want to help you learn and grow together as a family. Build a family routine that includes time spent reading the Bible and praying together. This could be in the morning, over dinner, at bedtime, or whenever else works for your family!

Family Activity:

Invite each family member to create a boat from aluminum foil. Fill a large bucket or sink with water to test the buoyancy of each boat. Discuss how scary Paul's shipwreck must have been. Paul trusted God because he knew God always keeps His promises.
