DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (Pick and adapt any that will help your group discuss the sermon.)

Let's Warm Up: Questions to break the ice.

1. What makes sense in your culture/language/background that is hard for outsiders to understand?
2. Have you ever experienced some unexpected cross-cultural influences?
3. Share about someone who explained the Good News of Jesus to you.
4. Explain a movie or show without context and see if others can guess what it is.

Let's Get Started: Questions to start thinking about the main themes.

5. Why does God use people to spread the Gospel (as opposed to angels, for example)?
6. What can make the Good News of Jesus confusing or difficult to understand for a new believer?
7. What concerns do the people around you have? How can we bridge those concerns to the Good News of Jesus?

Let's Dig In: Questions to discuss the passage and how we can respond.

8. How did God use persecution to expand His kingdom?
9. Why was the eunuch a surprising candidate for the Gospel?
Why was he a great candidate for the Gospel?
Why is it important to use the Bible to point to Jesus?
10. How can we practice sharing the Good News of Jesus in our Life Groups?
11. Who is the Holy Spirit directing you to share Jesus with?
