World Serve Ministries serves the church in Cuba by providing Bibles, church planting pastor support, theological training, marriage enrichment ministry for pastors, training and financial support for children's ministries and humanitarian aid for specific situations as the need arises. One of the other key ministry areas is assisting with micro business loans and training for Christian business people. The goal is to help the church become self-sustaining.

Vision Trip to explore partnership opportunities in Cuba

The team has been invited to assist with WorldServe's Microfinance Ministry. While the Cuban people are highly educated, the country's restrictive environment has limited their exposure to business principles and entrepreneurial ideas.

The team will work with Christian entrepreneurs, providing training, mentorship, and strategic guidance to help enhance local Micro Business projects. The primary goal of these projects is to equip individuals with sustainable means to support themselves, their families, and the local church as it serves the community in meaningful ways.

Additionally, throughout the week, team members will have the opportunity to assist in various ministries, including children's ministry, couples' ministry, administration, agriculture, and pastoral support.

The Cuba team can be 8 to 10 people and will last approximately 8 – 10 days. Lodging and transportation will be provided in the weeks closer to the trip. The trip involves visits to different churches or ministries located in different areas of the city.

Skills and experience required for team members:

- Background in Administration, Finance, Accounting, and home business
- Experience with Couples & Children ministries, and Pastoral support.
- Experience in Agriculture and fruit preservation such as mango.
