COURSE REGISTRATION
SPRING 2017

This course has grown out of a desire to develop a growing team of short-term workers that will be equipped to enter cross-cultural arena and effectively provide support to ongoing ministry projects or teams. **The purpose of the course is to provide foundational training to believers who desire to be involved in short-term ministry projects.**

While there have been some awesome ministry experiences, there have also been some disappointing ones. Teams have come unprepared, with more of a tourist agenda than a ministry agenda.

PROJECTS & GRADING
