BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Take some time to catch up. How did this week go? What steps of obedience did you take and what has God been teaching you?
2. Take time to read Revelation 1:9-20. What stands out to you from the text and/or sermon that Pastor Willy preached? Was there something you had not noticed before?
3. John calls himself a partner in the tribulation, the Kingdom, and the patient endurance that are in Christ Jesus (1:9). How are tribulation and patient endurance a part of your Christian walk?
4. The vision John sees communicates that Jesus is sovereignly in control and present in the midst of the churches. If you had to communicate that same truth, what imagery would you use?
5. Jesus is in the midst of the churches. He knows what they are going through and what they are doing. The same is true in our lives. Jesus is aware of the details of our lives. Does this truth bring you comfort or discomfort? Why?
6. How do you feel led to respond to this week's message and text? Are there steps of obedience you feel the Spirit asking you to take? How can we pray for you as a group?

In our over informed world we are being continually told what to believe, how to think, what is important, and what we should be concerned with. Given the overwhelming flow of information it can be very difficult to discern what is real and what is simply “fake news.” God’s intention for us is to live in reality, His reality. A reality that transcends the fake news of today and invites us to live with peace, grace, and confidence. The book of Revelation is written to persecuted church that needs to learn what God’s reality is in light of the challenges they face. Discover the reality that God reveals to us through His word to the first century church.

1. **Worship** prepares us to live in reality
2. We get a **picture** of **reality** when we see Jesus for who He really is
3. We need to **respond** to Jesus based on who **He is** not who we **think we are**
4. Jesus’ reality **meets** our deepest **longings**
5. We live in **reality** when we see life **through** the **unseen realities** of Jesus and His kingdom
