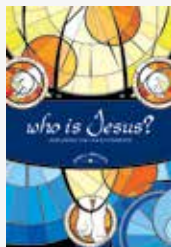

January 7 & 8, 2017

What kind of bread did you eat this week? When I walk up my street, I find Turkish bread, Mexican tortillas, Ukrainian bread, North American hamburger buns, French croissants and many other options. In many cultures around the world, bread is a staple. It symbolizes sustenance or life. If you think of bread as symbolic of sustenance, what was it that sustained you this week? What kept you alive?

1. Jesus says the bread of this world will **never endure**.
2. Jesus says the true bread of God **endures to eternal life**.
3. Jesus says **He is** the bread of God that satisfies our **hunger**.
4. Jesus wants nothing more than to see the **Father's will done**.
5. Jesus is determined to **never lose** what the Father has **given Him** – He can be **trusted!**
6. People are **drawn** to Jesus by **God, the Father**.
7. God **reveals** who He is through the **life and teaching of Jesus**.
8. To receive the bread of life **we must come** to Jesus.
9. The body of Jesus **was broken** on the cross so that we might have **the Bread of Life**.
