BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Take some time to catch up. How did this week go? What steps of obedience did you take and what has God been teaching you?
2. Take time to talk about what stood out to you from Christopher Yuan's message. Was there something you learned? Something that challenged you? A highlight?
3. When you introduce yourself, what do you say? Read John 1:12-13 and Acts 17:28. How does God describe our identity? Why do you think so many view sexuality as "who they are" rather than something they feel or do?
4. Do you feel freedom to admit the temptations you struggle with, or do you feel you need to keep them private, shared only with a select, trusted few? How can we make our church a safer and more redemptive place for those wrestling with same-sex temptations or any other temptation?
5. Paul writes, "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2). If a friend confides in you about a struggle or temptation they are facing, what would you do and say? What do you think it means to bear one another's burdens?
6. How do you feel led to respond to this week's message? Are there steps of obedience you feel the Spirit asking you to take? How can we pray for you as a group?
