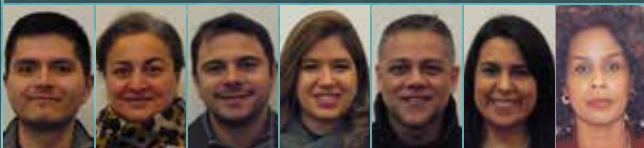

BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS

1. Take some time to catch up. How did this week go? What steps of obedience did you take and what has God been teaching you?
2. Take time to talk about what stood out to you from Pastor Ray's Sermon. Was there something you learned? Something that challenged you? A highlight?
3. The church in Sardis had a reputation for being alive, but they were dead. Is it possible to look spiritually alive on the outside, but to be spiritually dead on the inside? Where have you seen examples of this (both in the Bible and in your own life)?
4. When Jesus talks about the cause of the dead church of Sardis, he does not mention opposition, suffering, persecution or heresy. How could a church die if it was not experiencing any of these things? What else can kill a church?
5. Jesus uses similar language here as he does in the book of Matthew. Read Matthew 24:42-44. What does it mean for us as believers to stay awake? How does this prepare us for Christ's return?
6. How do you feel led to respond to this week's message and text? Are there steps of obedience you feel the Spirit asking you to take? How can we pray for you as a group?
