LIFE GROUPS

1. Take some time to catch up. How have you seen God at work in your life lately? What has He been teaching you? How have you been growing in your walk with God this week?
2. Read Matthew 28. Take time to talk about what stood out to you from Pastor Ray's sermon. Was there something you learned? Something that challenged you? A highlight?
3. How do you celebrate Easter with your family and loved ones? What traditions (religious or secular) do you hold?
4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:16-17. Discuss the connection between Jesus' resurrection and our faith. Why is the resurrection so important to Paul? What else would we lose if the resurrection didn't happen?
5. Jesus is alive! Take some time to talk about the personal significance of this statement to you. How does the truth of this Easter impact your day to day life?
6. How do you feel led to respond to this week's message and text? Are there steps of obedience you feel the Spirit asking you to take? How can we pray for you as a group?
